After Action Report

The Mississippi Wing Cadet Program Team hosted a Non-Commissioned Officer School (NCOS) on 24 to 26 October 2014 at Leroy Perc State Park in Hollandale, Mississippi. The NCOS was extremely successful with eleven students and five cadet instructors in attendance. Furthermore, the Mississippi Wing also hosted a Training Leaders of Cadets course where we were able to mentor an additional five new Cadet Program Officers.

The Cadet Students received instruction in to prepare for uniform inspection and how to conduct an open ranks inspection. Along with an overview on the operations of a guidon, how to organize physical fitness formation and how to drill an element size formation. Additionally they learned how to apply the core values to your NCO duties and how to develop and maintain effective communication. Cadet Students received hands on experience with a guidon, drilled an element size formation and conducted a physical fitness formation.

The Cadet Instructors were required to create a lesson plan and presentation and then present it to the students along with development of hip pocket training that required zero preparation time. The Cadet Instructors were able to develop their time management and most of all they were able to provide hands on experience in leading small group dynamics. Additionally, the instructors came from several different diverse squadrons and provided an opportunity to ensure consistency in cadet operations within Mississippi Wing.
